The petitioner has moved the instant application with a prayer for amendment of memo of parties in the main case.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the applicant is permitted to implead 'State of Punjab' as a party instead of 'State of Haryana'. The amended memo of parties is taken on record.

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The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.4 to 8 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 18.02.2023 (Annexure P-5) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and she shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 18.02.2023 (Annexure P-5).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2– Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

This order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the parties. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
