1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.269 dated 30.10.2015, registered for offence under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 17.02.2023, Annexure P-3, arrived at between the parties.
2. As per report received from the learned Judicial Magistrate, none of the parties have appeared before the Court for getting their statements recorded.
3. Upon instructions, State counsel submits that petitioner No.1, Kulwinder Singh Bajwa, was declared as a proclaimed offender on 08.03.2022.
4. While adjourning the matter, this Court by order dated 26.05.2023 directed the Registry to inform the counsel for the petitioners as well as respondent No.2 of the date fixed. Counsel for the parties have been informed, but there is no appearance on their behalf. It seems that the parties are not interested in pursuing the matter.
5. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
