Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.14 dated 28.01.2023, under Section 295-A IPC, (Section 380 of IPC added later on vide G.D. No.40 dated 17.02.2023) at Police Station Sadar Shri Muktsar Sahib, District Shri Muktsar Sahib.

Status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Satnam Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (PBI), NDPS-cum-Narcotics & Charge Sub-Division Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.

Vide order dated 23.02.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant

to order dated 23.02.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and as

such his interim bail may be made absolute.
