1. The present petition has been filed under Article 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajbir, submits that though the petitioner was a minor when her marriage was solemnized and from the said wedlock, a child was also born. However, matrimony ended up in a *panchayati* divorce on 22.04.2021. Thereafter, she has been living in relationship with another person.
