today the official from the concerned department is not present in the Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petitions are disposed of with liberty to the State to file an application for revival if there is any discrepancy.

The State is requested to recalculate the retiral pensionary benefits accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
