LISA GILL, J.

This appeal has been filed against judgment and decree dated 10.01.2020, passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Karnal, whereby petition under Section 13(1)(ia)(ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), filed by the respondent-wife, for dissolution of marriage, was allowed.

Parties, duly identified by their counsel, are present in Court and submit that the matter has been compromised with terms and conditions of settlement being reduced in writing on 07.02.2023. Parties further submit that settlement has been arrived at out of their own free will and volition without any pressure, coercion or undue influence from any quarter and they shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Appellant submits that in terms of the compromise, he seeks to withdraw this appeal and accept the judgment and decree dated 10.01.2020, passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Karnal, whereby petition under Section 13(1)(ia)(ib) of the Act, filed by the respondent-wife, for dissolution of their marriage, has been allowed.

Compromise dated 07.02.2023 is taken on record as A-1. Statements of parties with regard to the settlement agreement have been recorded separately.

Appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.
