The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 11 and not to interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners at behest of respondent No.4 and other relatives and friends.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad District Fatehabad (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 09.02.2023 (Annexure P-5) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner No.1 seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
