The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of 2nd petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.113 dated 05.04.2021 registered under Sections 186, 307, 353, 379, 380, 411, 457, 511 of the IPC & Section 25, 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar. The earlier petition bearing No.CRM-M-40088-2021 was dismissed as withdrawn on 20.07.2022 vide Annexure P-5.

2. Allegations are that 4-5 boys were trying to break open the shutter of a shop. While fleeing, one of them fired a shot from the pistol at the police party. Nobody was injured. Petitioner was caught at the spot and at that time he was armed with an iron rod.

3. It is contended by learned counsel that co-accused Sahil, Vishal & Sahil @ Hodika have already been allowed bail by the Trial Court vide

Annexure P-2 to Annexure P-4. Still further, it is contended that petitioner is in custody for the last more than 02 years 07 months; that trial may take time to conclude as out of 15 witnesses cited by the prosecution 10 have been examined so far.

4. Learned State counsel has opposed the bail petition by pointing out towards the nature of crime. However, it is conceded by learned State counsel that petitioner is in custody for the last 02 years and 07 months, which is also reflected in the custody certificate. It is further apparent from the custody certificate that though petitioner is involved in two more cases but he was acquitted in both of them.

5. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, particularly the long custody period of the petitioner but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
