Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint No.COMI-23 dated 16.07.2015 (P-17) instituted under Sections 211, 420, 463, 464, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 472, 473, 474, 475, 476, 477 & 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, '*the IPC*'); summoning order dated 21.02.2017 (P-24), passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar (Mohali) thereby summoning the petitioners to face trial under Section 420, 211 & 120-B of the IPC; and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
