Petitioner is praying for regular bail in case FIR No.84, dated 04.07.2022, registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 427, 323, 148, 149 and 120-B of IPC (Annexure P-1).

As per the FIR, petitioner is alleged to have given three direct blows with *datar* to Sandeep Kumar. One was hit on the left knee, second on the left hand thumb and third on the left shoulder. Thus, none of the injuries attributed to the petitioner has been caused on the vital part of the body.

Learned counsel for the petitioner draws attention towards the order dated 19.12.2022 passed in CRM-M-52514-2022, CRM-M-54065-2022 and CRM-M-53414-2022, whereby co-accused Mandeep Kumar @ Mandeep Singh @ Deepu, Sukhwinder Singh @ Sukha @ Alien and Chhinder Singh @ Chhinda had been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court. Another co-accused, namely, Sandeep Singh alias Sunny has been allowed regular bail vide order dated 18.01.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-1746-2023. One more co-accused, namely, Gurlal Singh @ Lalli has also been granted regular bail, vide

order dated 08.02.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-5710-2023.

As per custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody in this case for the last 7 months and 27 days, with no criminal antecedent.

Having regard to the role attributed to the petitioner and the fact that similarly placed co-accused have already been granted the benefit of bail and also the fact that trial may take time to conclude, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court concerned.
