On 27.02.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

'The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the impugned order dated 07.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar in case bearing CNR No.PSB03-001411/2017, Chi/190/2017 titled as 'State vs. Dharminder and others' arising out of FIR No.164 dated 15.10.2015 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station City, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person, on the basis of compromise dated 10.07.2021 (Annexure P-3).

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings.

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Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, for respondent No.1 as well as Mr. Vikas Sheel Verma, Advocate, accept notice on behalf of respondent No.2 respectively.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.50,000/- as costs with the Senior Citizen Home, Udyog Path, Sector 15-D, Chandigarh, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

*Let the separate replies on behalf of the respondents No.1 and 2 be filed well in time before the next date of hearing i.e. **11.05.2023** with copies thereof in advance to the counsel opposite.”.*

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, SBS Nagar and has since been admitted to bail as is borne out from the order dated 03.03.2023. A copy of the said order is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for a sufficient cause.
