Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix the seniority of the petitioner as per representations dated 16.07.2021 and 29.03.2022, Annexures P-10 and P-11 respectively as well as order dated 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-15) in a time bound manner.

Pursuant to order dated 27.02.2023 passed by this Court, affidavit of Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra has been filed, wherein, it has been submitted that representations given by the petitioner have been decided and order dated 12.07.2022 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

In view of the above, no purpose would be served in proceeding with this writ petition, which is hereby dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to challenge the order dated 12.07.2022 (Annexure R-1), if so advised.
