The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.421 dated 28.09.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420 & 506, 34 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal.

By virtue of the order dated 18.05.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is 80% handicapped and time and again he has joined the investigation. He also submits that the alleged money was paid directly to the co-accused, who has not been arrested by the Investigating Agency till date. He submits that the petitioner has already complied with the interim order and joined the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Agency and has fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Karambir, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation. He has further submitted that the co-accused is at large till date.

In view of the above, the order dated 18.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
