On 02.03.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 05.10.2019 passed by the trial Court, vide his bail/surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled and warrant of arrest has been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail and was regularly appearing before the trial Court, however, on 05.10.2019, he absented from the Court proceedings, as he was arrested in some other FIR. It is further submitted that thereafter, the police did not move any application for producing the petitioner on production warrants and in the meantime, his bail/surety bonds were cancelled. Learned counsel undertakes that the petitioner will appear before the trial Court within a period of one week from today.

Notice of motion for 11.05.2020.

In case the petitioner appears before the trial Court, he will be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the aforementioned order, the petitioner-Daljit Singh alias Jalad has appeared before the Court and is now facing trial.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
