The petitioners confine their prayer to issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 – the Station House Officer, Police Station Dhanas, UT Chandigarh to ensure that the petitioners are not harmed by the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankur Bali, Addl. PP, UT Chandigarh, who is present in Court pursuant to service of advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. He has submitted that as and when any representation is received by respondent No.3, the same shall be considered and disposed of in accordance with law.

In view of the aforestated position, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation as regards threat perception as and when the same is received by him in accordance with law at the earliest.
