Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the trial court to expeditiously dispose of the complaint filed by the petitioner against the respondents under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Since as on date all the accused are yet to be served, learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, seeks to withdraw the present petition.
