Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.37 dated 15.2.2015 registered under Section 302 IPC at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that on completion of investigation, the police presented challan under Section 304 IPC and thereafter trial Court also framed charges only under Section 304 IPC. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police by virtue of earlier order of interim bail passed

by the Coordinate Bench of this Court and handed over the concerned weapon to the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh apprised the Court that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and offence under Section 302 IPC is already deleted and the petitioner is facing charges under Section 304 IPC. The State counsel further apprised the Court that petitioner has joined the investigation and handed over the concerned fire arm and the petitioner is not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 2.3.2020 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
