The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 29.11.2018, vide which it was directed that the respondents will decide claim of the petitioner, however, restricted the benefit of arrears, if any payable, to 36 months.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on the basis of affidavit of Deputy Chief Engineer/Generation Circle ASHP, PSPCL, Anandpur Sahib, District Ropar, submits that the respondents-Corporation has accepted claim of the petitioner for grant of 23 years ACP benefit and as a consequence of the same, his basic pension stands revised from Rs.18,430/- to Rs.18,970/- and arrears of Rs.91,717/- in lieu of arrears for 36 months stands paid to the petitioner vide cheque dated 01.07.2020.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.
