The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 408 dated 20.09.2021, registered under Sections 148, 149, 302 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the trial is near completion and only one witness needs to be examined.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed but the direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.
