The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.311 dated 15.12.2022 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Special Task Force (Police Station at Mohali), District Fazilka.

As per the prosecution allegations, 100 grams of heroin and drug money of ₹2,77,000/- was recovered from the petitioner on 15.12.2022, which was taken into possession after making compliances of all the necessary provisions of law.

Admittedly the recovered contraband is of non-commercial quantity. However, in the status report filed on behalf of respondent-State it is submitted that petitioner is involved in two more cases of similar nature bearing FIR No.53 dated 20.04.2020 registered under Section 21/29 NDPS Act and 25 Arms Act registered at Police Station STF Phase-4 Mohali and FIR No.110 dated 14.05.2021 registered under Section 21 NDPS Act registered at Police Station City Jalalabad.

Custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel as per which, petitioner is in custody since 17.12.2022.

Having regard to the non-commercial quantity of the contraband but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
