Prayer in the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the show cause notices dated 09.02.2023 (Annexures P-8 to P-11) issued to the petitioners and to direct the respondents not to revert the petitioners on the basis of letter dated 30.09.2019 (Annexure P-12).

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners confines his arguments to the extent of issuance of direction to the official respondents to decide the case of the petitioners in a time bound manner after considering the present petition as reply to the show cause notices.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that the official respondents have

no objection in deciding the case of the petitioners in a time bound manner after considering the present petition as reply to the show cause notices, by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief claimed by them in the petition, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to supply the copy of the petition within 15 days to the appropriate authority, and the respondents are directed to decide the case of the petitioners after considering the present petition as reply to the show cause notices within ten weeks thereafter, in accordance with law.
