This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents to not to harass, humiliate and torture the petitioner by calling him illegally on the basis of false complaints actually made against the namesake owner (Gurpreet Singh son of Santokh Singh) of an immigration firm called M/s Next Immigration Services, Patiala and not to register false FIRs thereon against the petitioner without perusing the documents and clarifying the issue of identity.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to consider and decide the representation dated 01.02.2023 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
