The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take strict action against respondent No.4 who have illegally and wrongfully detained and misbehaved with the petitioners and to decided the representation dated 17.02.2023 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that one Sukhwinder Singh s/o Surjit Singh and Aman Jyoti daughter of respondents No.5 and 6 fall in love with each other and ran away from their houses. The private respondents instead of making efforts to trace out their girl and to nab the guilty person-Sukhwinder Singh, causing unnecessary harassment to the present petitioners only because the petitioners are the distant relatives of Sukhwinder Singh. The local police also without any basis is causing mental as well as physical harassment to the petitioners by repeatedly visiting their house and detaining their family members illegally.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, Senior D.A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and on instructions, submits that the present petition may be disposed of with direction to look into the representation dated 17.02.2023 made by the petitioners.

In view of the statement made by learned State Counsel but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to look into the representation dated 17.02.2023 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioners and take necessary action in accordance with law.
