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HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that respondent No.2 is offering deployment letters to Para Ayush Associates without preparing any merit list and the candidates are being deployed outside their districts, despite vacancy existing in a particular district for which the option has been given, which is against the policy dated 30.06.2022 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are seeking deployment in a district for which they have given options but respondents are not considering their options and are deploying them outside their district, which is arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that though notice of motion is yet to be issued but respondents were directed to submit certain information qua allegations levelled in the present petition, hence, the petitioners will be satisfied in case a direction is given to the respondent-department to decide the representation dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order. It is further prayed

that petitioners be given liberty to supplement representation dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) by filing a supplementary representation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents submits that in case any supplementary representation is submitted by the petitioners before the authority concerned within a period of 10 days from today, the same will be decided within a period of one month from the date of receipt of any such supplementary representation by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case the petitioners are found entitled for any benefit after the said decision, the same will be extended to them expeditiously.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty as aforesaid.

Ordered accordingly.
