Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 21.09.2018 (Annexure P-3), vide which petitioners No.4 and 5 have been reverted from the posts of Head Teachers, to the posts of Junior Basic Training (JBT) Teachers/Primary Teachers (PRT), and to the letter dated 01.04.2021 (Annexure P-10), vide which objection qua the claim of the petitioners for ACPs, has been raised.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that although Chatar Singh, one of the petitioners in CWP-31636-2019, did not possess the certificate of two years Junior Basic Training Course or Diploma in Education Training Course, yet he was promoted on the post of Primary Head Teacher and benefit of 3<sup>rd</sup> A.C.P. had been granted to him (however, learned counsel very fairly submits that he is not having the aforesaid order). Learned counsel further submits that similarly, the petitioners do not possess certificates of two years Junior Basic Training Course or

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Diploma in Education Training Course, but they have not been granted benefit of 3<sup>rd</sup> A.C.P.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners have already sent the legal notice dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-16) to respondent No.2-Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, for redressal of their grievance, which is still pending adjudication, and that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. R.S.Budhwar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-16) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioners during the course of hearing, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-16) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
