This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the notices dated 16.02.2023 (Annexures P-12 to P-17) issued by the Municipal Corporation, Jalandhar, directing the petitioners to remove the booths by 23.02.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that keeping in view the orders passed in the contempt petition, the petitioners seek to withdraw the present petition but state that since certain articles including computers etc. of the petitioners are lying there and they have been doing their business for the last 20 years, thus, time upto 15.03.2023 be granted to the petitioners to vacate the area and to remove their belongings. It is further submitted that after vacating the place, the petitioners will report to respondent no.2- Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Jalandhar.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

The petitioners are granted time till 15.03.2023 to vacate the place which is occupied by them and to remove their belongings and also to inform respondent no.2 after vacating the same, upto 15.03.2023.

In case the petitioners do not vacate the place uptill 15.03.2023, it would be open to the respondents to use police force to get the said place vacated.
