The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.139 dated 05.08.2022 registered under Sections 379-B, 323, 506, 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Gharinda, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

2. FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Boor Singh, as per which on 29.07.2022, he was taking his wife Seema Bai for treatment on his bike, when two unknown persons, having covered their face, came on the motorcycle armed with weapons. They stopped their bike, threatened them with arms and pulled the earrings of his wife Seema Bai, causing injuries to her.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention towards the statement of complainant Boor Singh Meena made before the Trial Court as PW-1 in which he clearly stated that he could not identify the accused

Harpreet Singh. Thus prosecution case is not supported by the complainant before the Trial Court.

4. As per the custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last 8 months and 17 days with no criminal antecedents.

5. Having regard to the factual position as above but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
