The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.108 dated 17.05.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149, 188 IPC (Sections 326 and 120-B IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Kathunangal, District Amritsar.

Ms. Himani Arora, AAG, Punjab, has appeared in this case in pursuance of the notice of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

Custody certificate filed by the learned State counsel is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that now the prosecution evidence has already been completed. He would be satisfied, if trial of the petitioner is concluded expeditiously.

As per the report of the learned trial Court, the case was adjourned to 12.04.2023 for recording statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

Taking note of the facts that the trial of the present case is at the

fag end and it can be expeditiously concluded, the present petition is *disposed of* with a direction to learned Trial Court to dispose of the case expeditiously, preferably within a period of *three months*.
