The present petition has been filed seeking regular bail to the petitioner in the FIR as captioned above.

2. A perusal of the petition reveals that the petitioner is involved in 17 more cases.
3. Status Report dated 17.04.2023 and Custody Certificate dated 19.04.2023 have been filed in the Court today and the same are taken on record.
4. Counsel for the State specifically pointed out towards paragraph nos.4, 5, 8 and 9 of the Status report and submits that due to supply of spurious liquor in various districts, a large number of people lost their lives and some lost their visions after consuming the spurious liquor. The petitioner was involved in a gruesome crime against society and such hooch tragedy has led to death of many and several has lost their eye sight. The petitioner has criminal history of heinous crimes. Furthermore, the

petitioner was not refer to any averment based on which this Court is assured that if this recidivist is released on bail, then he shall not indulge in criminal behavior.

5. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
