1. The present petition has been filed raising a prayer that the medical bills amounting to Rs.2,03,225/- which the petitioner has submitted with the respondents, is not being reimbursed and that too without any valid justification.
2. From the perusal of the record, it transpires that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised through a representation dated 22.12.2020 (Anenxure P-4) to respondent No.2 and the same is pending consideration before the authorities concerned, hence the interest of justice will be served in case respondent No.2 where the said representation is pending consideration is directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.
3. Notice of motion to respondents.
4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court,

accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana-respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation in a time bound manner.

5. Learned State counsel submits that in case the said representation dated 22.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) has not already been decided by respondents so far, the same will be considered and decided within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order and in case after the decision of representation, any benefit accrues, the same will also be extended to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.

6. Keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed.
