1. The learned counsel appearing for the litigants are ad-idem that this Court may dispose of the instant writ petition, with a mandamus, upon, the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat concerned, or the BDPO concerned, to after holding fresh valid demarcation by the Revenue Officer concerned, thus of the relevant sites, but under the supervision of the SDM concerned, to, in case there are detection therein, about encroachment(s) being made over the disputed land, to thereafter forthwith institute a petition under Section 7 of the Haryana Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, before the competent authority concerned. The said prayer is allowed. Ordered accordingly.

2. Moreover, till the institution of the said motion before the Assistant Collector 1st Grade concerned, thereupto the parties are directed to maintain status-quo in respect of disputed land.

3. However, on the institution of the said petition, the petitioners shall file an application claiming any interim relief, as deemed fit, and, on such an application, a lawful order shall be passed by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade concerned. Moreover, the said petition shall be lawfully decided within four months of its preferment.

4. Disposed of as such.

5. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
