By this petition, the petitioner is seeking directions in the nature of certiorari to quash order dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-12) passed by the appellate authority of the respondent council vide which the appeal filed by the petitioner-institution dated 23.10.2018 (Annexure P-11) has been rejected.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the recognition has been withdrawn on the basis that the petitioner did not have requisite built up area of 3000 sq. mts. as well as infrastructure facility for two courses i.e. D.El.Ed and B.Ed course vide order dated 29.12.2016 (Annexure P-6) and, thereafter, appeal filed by the petitioner has been rejected vide order dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-12).

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, states that the petitioner wishes to continue only with one course i.e. B.Ed and for this purpose, the petitioner can make a fresh application giving details of

infrastructure facilities and faculties.

This petition, at this stage, is being disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to make appropriate application to respondent No.1 for granting recognition of only B.Ed course within a period of two weeks and thereafter, respondent No. 1 will pass appropriate order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of such application.
