1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
126	21.04.2019	Nissing, Karnal	148, 149, 323, 324, 302, 452, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act

2. Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Head Quarter), Karnal has been filed on behalf of respondent – State, which is taken on record.

3. Heard counsel for the parties.

4. While deciding the bail petition bearing CRM-M-26850-2022

preferred by a co-accused, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 27.07.2023 has directed that the ‘trial be expedited’.

6. The petition is dismissed.
