Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is to the notice dated 10.01.2020 (Annexure P-1). The securitization proceedings were issued in the form of possession notice on account of the outstanding amount of Rs.9,86,214/- as on 22.05.2019.

Vide order dated 02.03.2020, the petitioner was directed to deposit a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- within a period of four weeks. The order was conditional that if the amount was not deposited within the prescribed period, the interim order would cease to operate. Process fee has not been filed and resultantly on 21.09.2022, directions were issued to file process fee within two weeks. Counsel for the petitioner was not present on that date. As per office report, needful has not been done. Counsel for the petitioner is not present today also.

Keeping in view the above, we are of the considered opinion that the petitioner has lost interest in the litigation. Accordingly, the present writ

petition stands dismissed for want of prosecution. All interim orders stand automatically vacated.
