A perusal of the report dated 15.03.2023 indicates that the accused/applicant-Kuldeep Singh already stands acquitted in case FIR No. 152 dated 07.11.2020, registered under Sections 420 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot and therefore, the instant petition does not survive in the light of the aforesaid facts. Further, the order dated 28.02.2023 has also become absolute and need not required to be complied with for enquiring and recording the statement of parties with regard to the compromise.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
