Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0050 dated 23.02.2022, under Section 25 of Arms Act and Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Jhajjar.

Vide order dated 08.02.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 08.02.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He also submits that the parties have compromised the dispute amicably.

Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Anil, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 08.02.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
