This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to take appropriate action against respondent No.4 as respondent No.4 who is Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat Farmana Mahlan is stated to be in illegal possession over the panchayat land.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Krishan, LO (Panchayat) Sonipat, has submitted that in the present case, in pursuance of the complaint given by the petitioner, the Deputy Commissioner has constituted a Committee which also consists of Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Kharkhoda, Tehsildar and BDPO Kharkhoda for inquiring into the

matter and would proceed with the inquiry as expeditiously as possible and would make every endeavour to finish the same within a period of one month from today and in case, anything is found against respondent No.4 in pursuance of the said inquiry, then the appropriate action, in accordance with law, would also be taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the abovesaid statement made by learned State Counsel, the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous and thus, the same may kindly be disposed of as such at this stage and further prays that State would be bound by the abovesaid statement.

In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage.
