This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.95 dated 27.09.2008 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur and all subsequent proceeding arising therefrom including order dated 01.02.2010, whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender, on the basis of compromise dated 30.11.2016 (Annexure P-3).

The present petition was preferred in the year 2019 and the same has been adjourned from time to time either on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner or for his non-appearance.

Vide order dated 02.07.2019, liberty was granted to the petitioner to place on record the relevant documents pertaining to the petitioner having been declared a proclaimed offender, but the same has not been complied with till today.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner even on the last date of hearing and today also, learned counsel for the petitioner is not present to address arguments.

In view of the above, it appears that counsel for the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition any further and the same stands dismissed in default.
