The petitioner alleges violation of the directions/guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Arnesh Kumar vs. State of Bihar & another, 2014 (8) SCC 73*.

Reply, filed by way of the affidavit of the DSP, Sub Division Kharar-I, District SAS Nagar, is on record. As per reply, the petitioner is an accused in FIR No. 211 dated 11.11.2021, registered under Sections 307, 427, 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Phase-I, District SAS Nagar. Vide orders dated 16.12.2021 and 10.02.2022 passed in CRM-M-52452-2021, the petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail. It is further stated in reply that in pursuance thereof, petitioner Banty and his co-accused Gaurav and Ravi were joined in investigation, however, it is clarified that the petitioner was later on arrested in another FIR No. 13 dated 25.01.2022, registered under Sections 302, 323, 324, 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar and till date, he has not been granted the bail.

In view of the above, no case of contempt is made out.

The present petition is dismissed accordingly.
