The petitioner alleges that his children are in the illegal custody of respondents No.8 & 9 to whom the wife i.e. respondent No.7 has transferred custody. Respondent No.8 is the sister of respondent No.7. Thus, the present petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not aware of the whereabouts of his children. Thus, a representation dated 02.02.2023 (Annexure P-7) has been submitted before respondent No.6 but no action has been taken thereupon till date. He may be directed to decide the aforementioned representation in accordance with law. Other relief sought in the petition are being given up.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 6 only.

Mr. Harkanwarjit Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed no reply is necessary.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6 to decide the pending representation dated 02.02.2023 (Annexure P-7) by taking into consideration all the facts and circumstances of this case and by passing a speaking order within four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
