Both the above mentioned petitions are being decided by a common order as the issue involved therein is identical.

The present petitions have been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari raising a challenge to the order dated 16.02.2000, whereby the election to the Central Council of Indian Medicine for two seats from the State of Punjab had been declared as null and void and consequently, the membership of the petitioners to the Central Council of Indian Medicine had also been set aside. Apparently, the issue involved is stayed. The petitioners seemingly have no subsisting interest in pursuing their respective petitions. The tenure for which the petitioners would have been elected has also come to an end. Also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners successively for the last two dates. The position remains the same even today.

The petitions are accordingly dismissed for want of prosecution.
