RAJESH BHARDWAJ J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for direction to respondent No.4 not to threat/harass the petitioner and his family members not to implicate them in false case in case the petitioner will not compromise the matter with accused persons in case FIR No.52, dated 08.05.2019, under Sections 307/323/324/341/148/149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar.

2. This Court had issued notice to the respondents. In pursuance to the same, learned counsel for the State has been filed status report by way of affidavit of Waryam Singh Khehra, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted before this Court that the petitioner is the complainant in FIR No.52, dated 08.05.2019. He has

submitted that the petitioner filed one representation before the Commissioner, Jalandhar regarding the allegations raised in the present petition. However, he submits that the same was dealt with and was not substantiated on the inquiry. It was also submitted before this Court that investigation in FIR No.52, dated 08.05.2019 is already complete and charges were framed and as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner, the complainant is also examined before the trial Court and he has duly supported the case of the prosecution.

4. In view of the submission made by the counsel for parties, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the competent authority in case he has any surviving grievance and the said authority would take action thereon as per law.
