ANIL KSHETARPAL, J(Oral)

1. This revision petition has been preferred by one of the judgment debtors against the order passed by the Executing Court while dismissing his objection petition. The decree between the parties has become final. In order to give effect to the decree passed, the decree holder filed the execution petition, in which the objections were filed. The same were dismissed by the Executing Court by a detailed order. It was noticed that the petitioner failed even in the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

2. It has been brought to the notice of the Court that various writ petitions filed between the parties were allowed and the matter was remitted back to the authorities. The Executing Court has held that in absence of any injunction order restraining the Executing Court from implementing the decree, it would not be appropriate to keep the execution petition in abeyance.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.

- 4. Dismissed accordingly.
- 5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
