RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for handing over the investigation of the case to CBI or to some other independent agencies.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that son of the petitioner died in mysterious circumstances and the same has not been investigated.

On the directions of this Court, the State was directed to file status report which has been filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Ravinder Sangwan, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kaithal.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the allegations made by the petitioner in the petition are without any substance. He has submitted that on the receipt of information regarding the incident, the body was collected and it was sent for postmortem. He has submitted that

a thorough inquiry was conducted and death of the son of the petitioner was found due to accident. He submits that the motorcycle on which son of the petitioner was travelling was found to be a stolen one and FIR No.516/2014 under Section 379 IPC has been registered in Police Station Sadar Karnal which was also taken into police possession. He submits that from the thorough inquiry conducted, no foul play was found and it was found that son of the petitioner died due to the accident.

Heard. After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that no foul play has been found during the inquiry conducted and thus, this Court does not find any merit in the petition filed by the petitioner for handing over the investigation to the CBI. However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail his alternative remedy as available to him under law.

Disposed of.
