The instant application is for pre-poning the date of hearing of the main petition to an early date.

Notice in the application.

At this stage, Mr. Indresh Goel, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and does not oppose the prayer.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and hearing of the main case is pre-poned to today.

Main case

By means of this writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue as guest faculty till regular appointments are made and further to issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari to quash the practice of the respondent University to replace the

petitioner with similar set of employee and to restrain them from making fresh appointments against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the writ petition stands redressed, who has been taken back in service, therefore, he has instructions to withdraw this writ petition.

The prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
