1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he shall confine his prayer only to the relief of issuing appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as he apprehends threat at the instance of respondents No. 4 and 6 and submits that for the other reliefs claimed in the present petition, he shall avail his remedies, in accordance with law.

2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was being threatened by respondents No. 4 to 6 and even he had submitted a complaint/representation (Annexure P-3) to the police officials but no action was taken on the same.

3. On the other hand, a status report by way of an affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Gurugram (East) has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Learned State counsel submits that complaints bearing numbers 10879 dated 28.04.2022, 2348-Z dated 05.05.2022,

00013227087220249 dated 06.05.2022, 3506-D/Spl dated 07.07.2022, 7662 dated 02.06.2022, 7886 dated 07.07.2022, 13227087220392 dated 14.07.2022, 00013227087220422 dated 23.07.2022, 3659-A dated 20.07.2022 were filed by the petitioner against respondents No. 4 to 6 at Police Station Sector 40 Gurugram. The complaints were inquired into by ASI Parveen Kumar. During the course of inquiry, it was found that the dispute between the parties was already sub-judice before the the National Company Law Tribunal and no action by the local police was required in the present case and the complaints submitted by the petitioners were ordered to be filed by the local police. Learned State counsel has assured the Court that in case any further complaint is received from the petitioner with regard to the threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, necessary action shall be taken in the said case, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above statement, nothing survives in the present petition and the same stands disposed off accordingly.
