1. Through this revision petition, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners assail the correctness of the warrants of possession issued by the Executing Court on 18.12.2018 and 04.02.2019. The petitioners claim that the warrants of possession have been issued beyond the decree passed by the learned District Judge.
2. On a court question, the learned counsel representing the petitioners admits that against the order directing issuance of warrants of possession, no objection petition before the Executing Court has been filed.
3. On the other hand, the learned counsel representing the respondent submits that he has no objection if the petitioners file the objection before the Executing Court, which shall be decided within a period of one month, from today.
4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and no objection by the learned counsel representing the respondent, the revision petition is disposed of accordingly.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
