The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 56 dated 02.02.2023 registered under Sections 420, 120-B and 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 23, 25, 4, 5(2), 6(c) of the Pre-Natel Diagnostic Techniques Act, 1994 at Police Station City Bahadurgarh District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that on the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been stated that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Karan Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 27.02.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
