Bank of Maharashtra has filed the instant writ petition seeking a mandamus for directing the official respondents to execute and implement orders passed by the Additional District Magistrate concerned at Annexures P-6 and P-7 carrying even date i.e. 21.05.2021.

Counsel submits that inspite of the respondent/authorities having been approached repeatedly, physical possession of the mortgaged properties had not been delivered till date.

In the light of the limited prayer made in the writ petition, there would be no requirement of seeking a written response to the writ petition at the hands of the State.
