For the reasons as are mentioned in the application,the same is *allowed*. Condonation of 07 days’ delay in late filing of the appeal is condoned.

Main case

[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the appellant states that he does not press the instant appeal and would release the payment to the respondents-claimants in terms of the award, however, the interest of the Insurance Company be protected as in majority of such like cases, the owner disposes of the property, resulting in the Insurance Company not being able to recover the compensation paid in terms of the award.

[2] Needless to mention, the grievance of the appellant is without any basis as firstly admittedly the compensation as awarded by the learned Tribunal has not been released by the Insurance Company and secondly, it would always be open to the appellant to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law before the appropriate forum to seek orders to protect its interest.

[3] Disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
